Peer Mentoring?

- The Peer Mentoring Program aims to provide support from one pupil, to another. This is done to support pupils to settle in, to make progress and to achieve their full potential in Ysgol Calon Cymru.
- The Wellbeing Ambassadors have undergone training to partake in peer mentoring. A peer mentor is a role model student, who offers support to another student in the school. The role will be supported by the school. During the peer mentor training, the Wellbeing Ambassadors have learnt about safeguarding and maintaining boundaries. A mentor is someone who will be listening to another person talk about their concerns.
- ♦ The school ensures the safety of all individuals by offering 'supervision' to all of the peer mentors.
- Peer mentors will listen and respect the opinion of others.
- A peer mentor will learn to ask open questions and closed questions to support the mentee.
