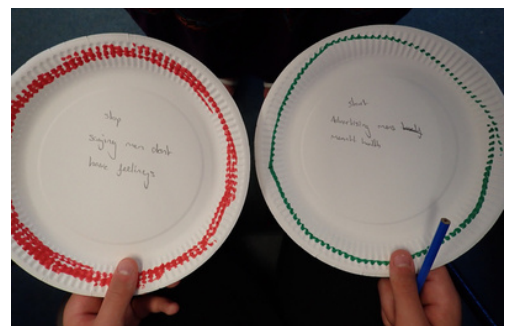
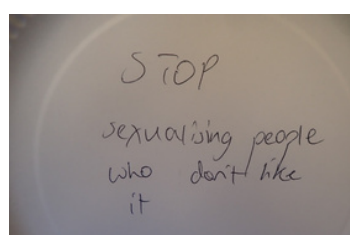
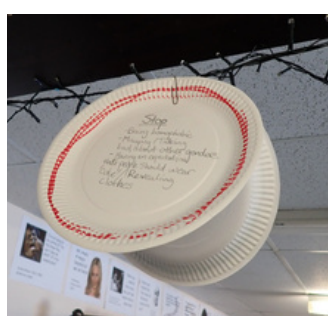
Relationships and Sexual Education Workshops

Yn unol â'r cwricwlwm newydd a'r fframwaith ACRh mae pob Arweinydd Grŵp wedi gweithio gyda'u grwpiau blwyddyn i gyflwyno i'n dysgwyr rai o'r materion a phynciau y mae'n rhaid iddynt wybod amdanynt a dysgu amdanynt. Cafodd pob dosbarth ym mlwyddyn 9 sesiwn i ddarganfod beth sy'n eu pryderu, yr hyn y mae'n ofynnol iddynt wybod yn eu hoed hwy a sut y mae'n rhaid i ni weithredu ac ymateb mewn modd cyfrifol i ddiogelu ein hunain a grymuso ein gilydd gyda'r wybodaeth gywir yn y byd cyfoes. In line with the new curriculum and RSE framework all Progress Leaders have worked with their year groups to introduce our learners some of the issues and topics that they need to be aware of and learn about. Each class in year 9 had a session to discover what they are concerned about, what they need to know at their age and how we need to act and react in a responsible way to protect ourselves and empower each other with the right knowledge and information in today's world. Now that we have conducted a school wide audit of what needs to be done and how pupil, staff and parent voice can inform us of views and a need for learning, we can embed good practice into our curriculum with correct up to date knowledge and learning. Starting in the Autumn term there will be a series of drop-down mornings to deliver each strand on Relationships and Identity, Sexual Health and Wellbeing and Empowerment, Safety and Respect.
